Trumenba is a vaccine to prevent invasive meningococcal disease, caused by Neisseria meningitidis serogroup B bacteria, for use in people aged 10 through 25 years. Invasive meningococcal group B disease (also known as meningitis B) is a serious and sometimes life-threatening bacterial infection that can result in meningitis (inflammation of the covering of the brain and spinal cord) and sepsis (blood poisoning). Meningitis B can spread from person though close contact (such as coughing or kissing) or lengthy contact, especially among people living in the same household.

Trumenba will only protect against diseases caused by *Neisseria meningitidis* serogroup B bacteria covered by the vaccine. Trumenba will not protect 100% of those who receive the vaccine.
